Production

This year, the production is Mary Poppins. We will be working hard in school and need as much support to practice at home please. The children are certainly looking forward to it as much as we are. This term, we will be creating costumes, exploring theatre equipment but most of all being the best that we can be. We will also have some support from Tonbridge School with this, which we are always very grateful for.

<u>Science</u>

In Science this term, Year 6 will be exploring Animals including humans. They will be exploring the functions of the body and the main parts of the circulatory system. They will be looking at the changes and impacts that can be made to support the body. The children will be taking part in several investigations

to see how exercise has an impact and on what parts of the body, including the muscles.

<u>English</u>

This will give them an opportunity to show off numerous narrative writing skills, including the use of figurative language, high-level punctuation and their ability to integrate dialogue. After this, we will look at play scripts and the work of William Shakespeare. They will continue to read daily, either independently or as a group.

<u>R.E.</u> Last term we didn't complete our R.E. unit so will continue to focus on the Hindu religion and beliefs.

<u>Maths</u>
