Use the ingredients found to create a recipe and make it at home. Take a picture of your final creation and bring it in – or make enough to share with the class (and teachers!).</p>

Try to include, the costings of hotels, flights and any include trips to visit landmarks. Does this country have a rainforest for people to visit? Use your creative imagination to create the rainforest in a jar or bottle.
