Term 4

Dear parents and carers, term 4 already, can you believe it? It is a busy one!

History

This term we will be continuing our History topic which is London, Kings and Queens. Children will be learning significant people from the past in 'The Great Fire of London', such as Samuel Pepys. We will also learn about the impact the fire caused on travel and trade within the city and understand how London was rebuilt.

Science

In Science, we are continuing our topic of animals including humans. Children will continue to reason why animals are suited to different habitats and what their diets are. They will also learn to sort out animals into different categories. We will also understand the terms herbivore, carnivore and omnivore.

English

This term in English all our learning will be based around the story book 'The curious case of the missing mammoth' by Ellie Hattie & Karl James Mountford. Our writing outcome is to write a story based on the structure of the story with a change of character. The children will continue to punctuate sentences using a capital letter and a full stop, question mark or exclamation mark.

Maths

This term in maths, the children will be strengthening their knowledge by using their number bonds to 10 and applying these strategies within 20. The children will be focussing on addition and subtraction within 20 using ten frames, part whole model and number lines.

PSHE

This term our topic is healthy me. The children will understand why it important to stay healthy and understand what they can do to help their bodies.

Spanish

During term 3, children will be learning about superheroes.

Phonics

Children will continue to practise daily phonics to help them decode and blend sounds to form words. Please continue to read with your child every night with their home reading book!

RE

This term children will continue to look into the religion Judaism.

Computing

In computing, children will learn to use purple mash to search effectively and safely on the internet.
