

Geography

In this unit, children will learn about the different layers of the Earth — the crust, mantle, and core — and be able to explain their features and characteristics. They will explore the causes of volcanic eruptions and earthquakes, and describe what happens during these natural disasters using diagrams and appropriate geographical vocabulary. Children will also consolidate their map and globe skills by locating major volcanoes around the world and identifying areas where significant earthquakes have occurred.

Our topic this term is plants. We will be observing and describing how seeds and bulbs grow into mature plants. Year 2 will consolidate their understanding of shape by revisiting and deepening their knowledge of 3D shapes. Following this, they will begin exploring fractions, learning to recognise and find $\frac{1}{4}$, $\frac{1}{2}$, and $\frac{3}{4}$ of shapes and quantities.

Year 3:

Year 3 will also be focusing on fractions this term. They will explore both unit and non-unit fractions, understand tenths as part of a whole, find fractions of numbers, and begin identifying equivalent fractions.
