You could use paper mache, or use recycling materials and glue them together. Or if you can think of another creative way then that is fine!:)</p>	<p><u>Science</u></p> <p>Go on a walk and find different types of rocks.</p> <p>Can you take pictures and identify if there are any layers, grains or crystals.</p> <p>If you can't take a photo, could you draw it and label where you can see the grains, layers or crystals?</p>
