

<p>Science</p> <p>Research a rainforest animal of your choosing and explain how it is adapted to life in the rainforest. For example, sloths use camouflage and move slowly to make it difficult for predators to spot them. Other animals you might choose: tree frog, spider monkey, mountain gorilla.</p>	<p>Impress me!</p> <p>Research a country in South America and create a fact file about it. Your information file will need sections on at least 4 of the following areas: the climate and weather, the history of the country, the traditional clothes worn, the sports played, food and drink, the culture, animals and plants that live there.</p>	<p>Write and Draw</p> <p>You are an intrepid explorer and discovered a new animal unknown to man in the Amazon Rainforest. Draw and label a picture of this new animal. Write a description of it including what it looks like, how it behaves, what it eats, where it lives and any other details that make this new creature unique.</p>
<p>Write</p> <p>You are an explorer in the Amazon Rainforest. Write a diary entry to describe what you do and see whilst you are there.</p>	<p>Into the Jungle!</p> <p>Choose 6 activities to complete this term.</p>	<p>Research and Bake</p> <p>Research food from a South American country of your choice. Write up the recipe and make it at home. Take a picture of your final creation and bring it in – or make enough to share with the class (and teachers!).</p>
<p>Research and write</p> <p>Write a biography about a famous scientist (such as Mary Anning, Charles Darwin or Alfred Wallace). You can use websites, but the writing should be in your own words. You can include pictures (drawn or printed).</p>	<p>Every week you must also:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Read your reading book. ● Practise your times tables – join in the TTRS battles. ● Practise your spellings. <p>Talk about your homework at home.</p>	<p>Book Review</p> <p>Write a book review on a book you have recently read. Remember that presentation is very important. Include lots of pictures and a little bit of information about the book (don't give the ending away though!)</p>
<p>Maths</p> <p>You know that knowing your times tables is very important if you want to succeed in Maths. Create a game that would help children learn their tables or research the free games available on the internet and write a report to explain which is the best.</p>	<p>Computing</p> <p>Create a model of a new 5 star hotel which is to be built in the middle of the Amazon Rainforest using Minecraft or another computer design program. What features would you want to include to make people want to visit?</p>	<p>Painting</p> <p>Image search the art of Amazonian artist Nixiwaka Yawanawa. Key features include bright colours and patterns. Either replicate one of his existing pieces or create your own in the same style. You could use paints, chinks, oil pastels or pens (feel free to borrow from school if needed).</p>
