Phoenix class will be taking part in a Safety in Action event on **Tuesday 18 April** (the venue will be confirmed shortly). 'Safety in Action' is an interactive event for Year 6 children to learn about some of the dangers they may face as they become more independent and prepare for transition to secondary school. More information can be found in the attached letter from the Salus Group, which also requests pupil information for monitoring purposes.

The children will be taken to and from the event by coach, and should be back in time for collection as normal, although if the traffic is bad they may be a little late.

They will need to bring a packed lunch in a disposable named bag (no fizzy drinks, sweets or chocolate bars). Children should wear school uniform with a coat and sensible shoes.

The cost of the trip will be £11, which is part funded by KCC and includes the cost of the transport. This is a voluntary contribution, but if we do not receive enough money for the trip by Monday 20 March this trip will not be able to go ahead.
