



# Ways to support your child further:

## General

- School day begins at 8.30 and children come in through KS1 area.
- 

**English** - you can include the following or anything that you would like your parents to support with

- Ensure your child reads daily
- If possible, read to your child regularly, accessing texts that they wouldn't necessarily tackle themselves.
- Encourage your child to read a wide range of books from the library, including non fiction texts. Our class library session is Mondays.
- **Practise with your child their spellings, ensuring that they can write them within sentences.**

**Maths** - you can include the following or anything that you would like your parents to support with that supports whatever your mathematical learning is this term.

- **Practise times tables regularly**, ensuring they are able to answer questions relating to these randomly, without having to work them out.
- Challenge children to speed up their mental addition and subtraction skills to support confidence in written calculation.
- Encourage your child to measure things in 'real' contexts and wherever possible convert between units eg kg to g and cm to m and vice versa.

**Wider Curriculum** - anything that would support other areas of your curriculum eg.

- Look around Tonbridge to find any historical evidence of Anglo Saxons living here
- See if you can find out if your surname is Anglo Saxon
- Have fun writing playing games writing messages using runes
- Discuss in your family how your show kindness to each other
- Listen together to other pieces of music by Beethoven. Discuss why you might like or not like music by this composer.
