The children will be taking part in a range of activities based around the Olympics. Some of the activities will include: dance, smoothie making, speed stacking and making sail boat.

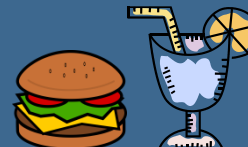
